Market highlights Q1

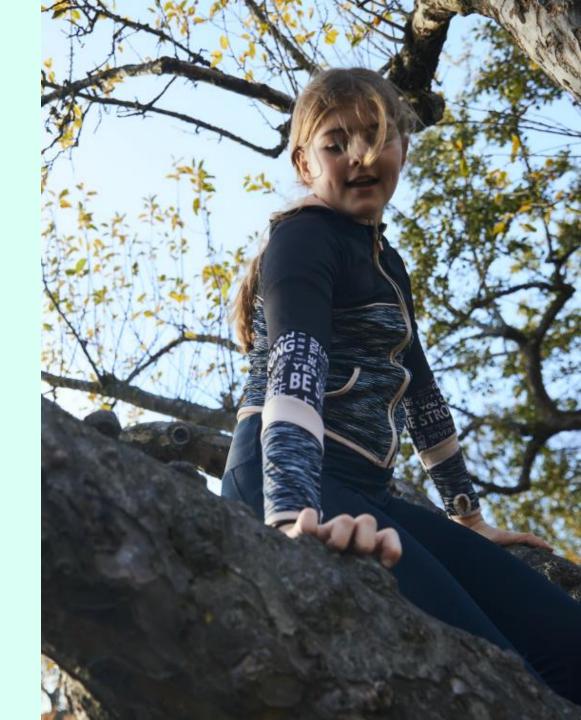
- Number of sold units to consumer gradually increasing
- Continued improvement in the market with most positive signs in Sweden
- Investor market still more challenging



Significantly reduced net debt

Q1 figures in brief

- Low volume of recognised units
- Underlying gross margin of 10.2 per cent (8.6)
- Indirect and S&A expenses down 21 per cent net compared to Q1 last year
- Net debt significantly reduced SEK 4.3 Bn (8.1)
- All conditions in financing package fulfilled

In the centre of Uppsala Bonava is planning to build a neighbourhood of 113 units. The project is located in a historical environment called Seminarieparken. Sales start will be on 28 April.



Düsseldorf, Germany, Paulshöfe

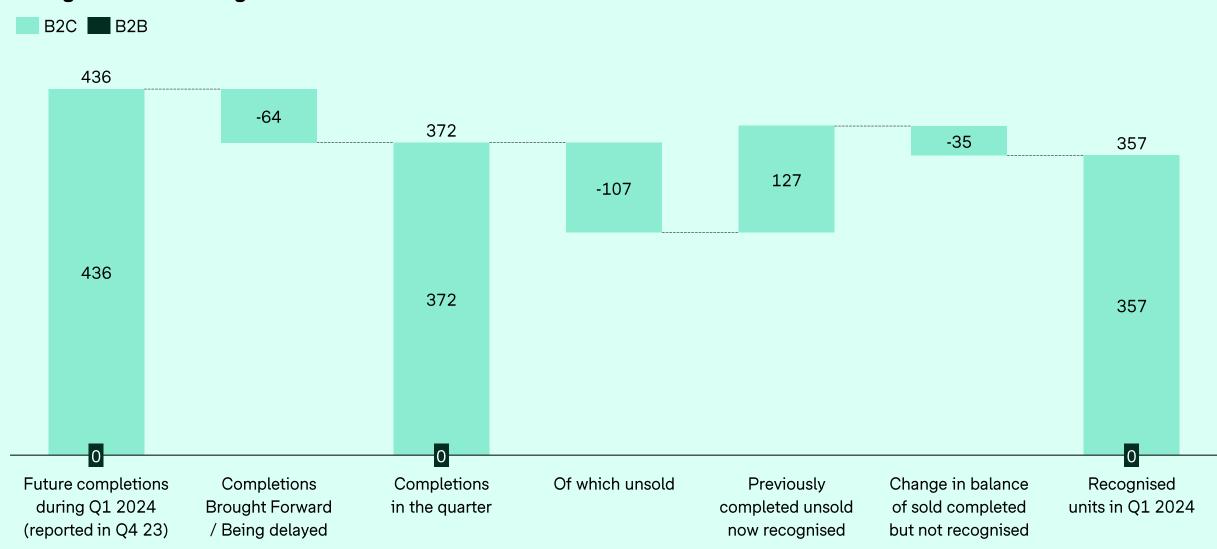
In Düsseldorf Bonava is planning to build a neighbourhood of 550 units. The energy-efficient housing units will feature rooftop solar panels and greenery.

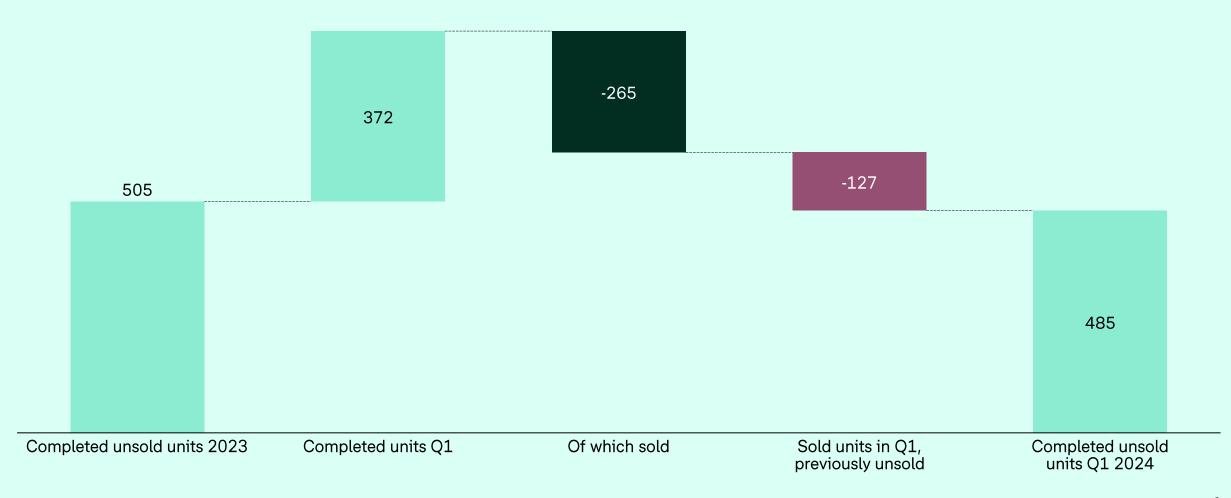

Recognised units bridge



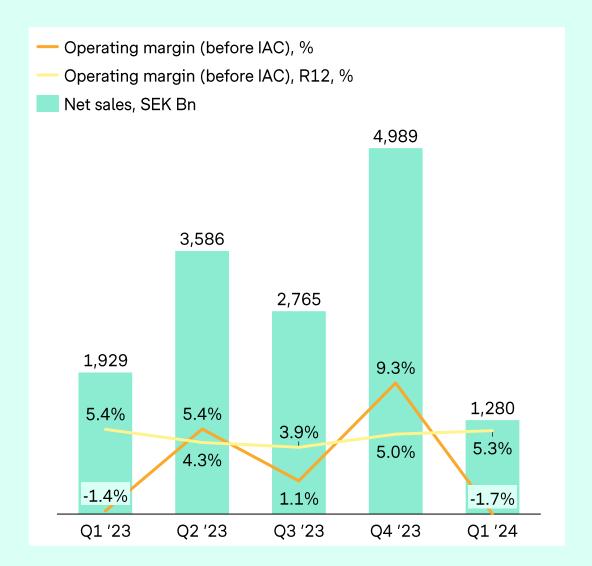

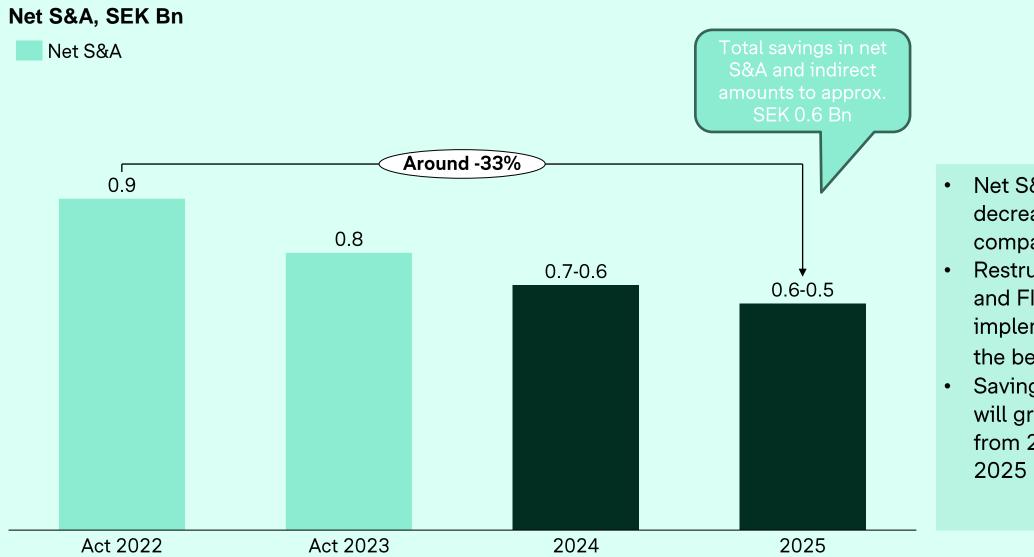

Continued implementation of restructuring measures



- Net S&A and indirect decrease 21 per cent compared to Q1 LY
- Restructuring in SE and FI has been implemented since the beginning of 2024
- Savings in Germany will gradually come from 2024, full effect 2025

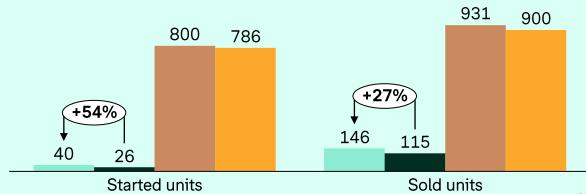
- Increase in started units to consumer. Sold units to consumer up 27 per cent compared to last year
- Net sales higher due to more units for consumers recognised
- Improved operating margin with lower S&A

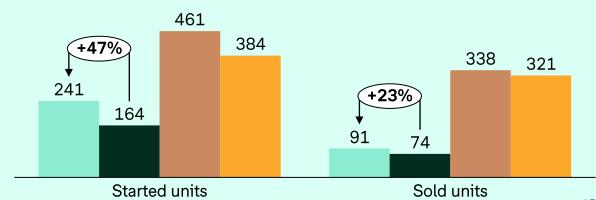

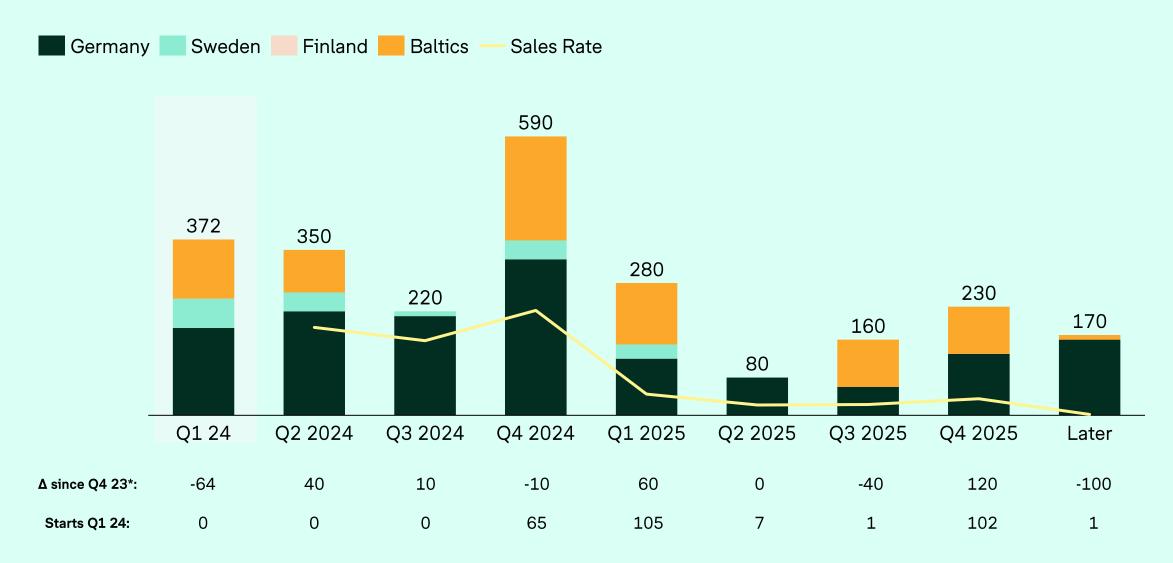

Investors - expected completions and sales rate

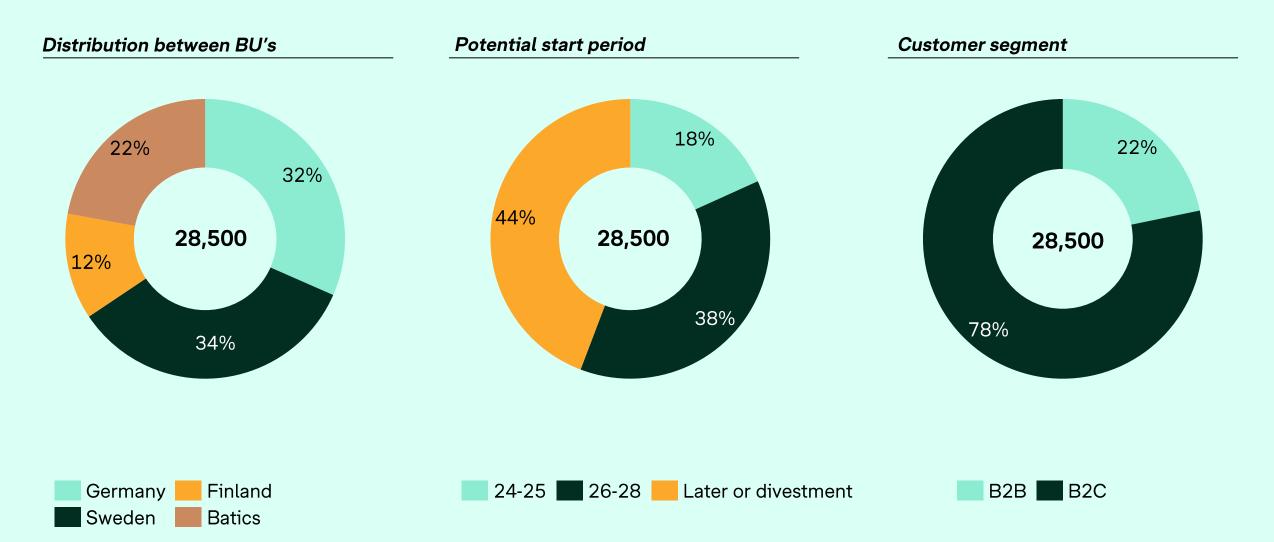

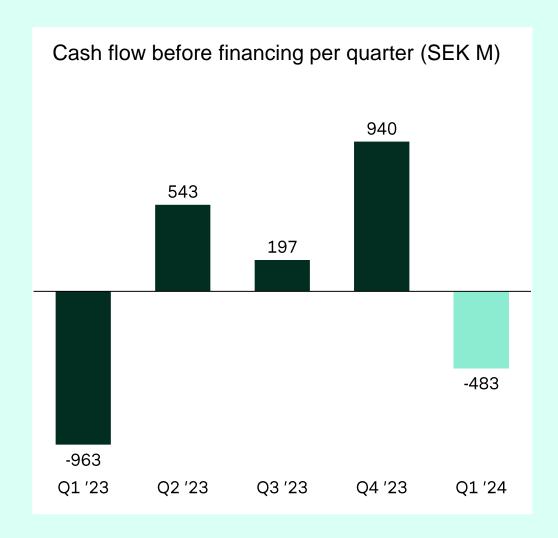

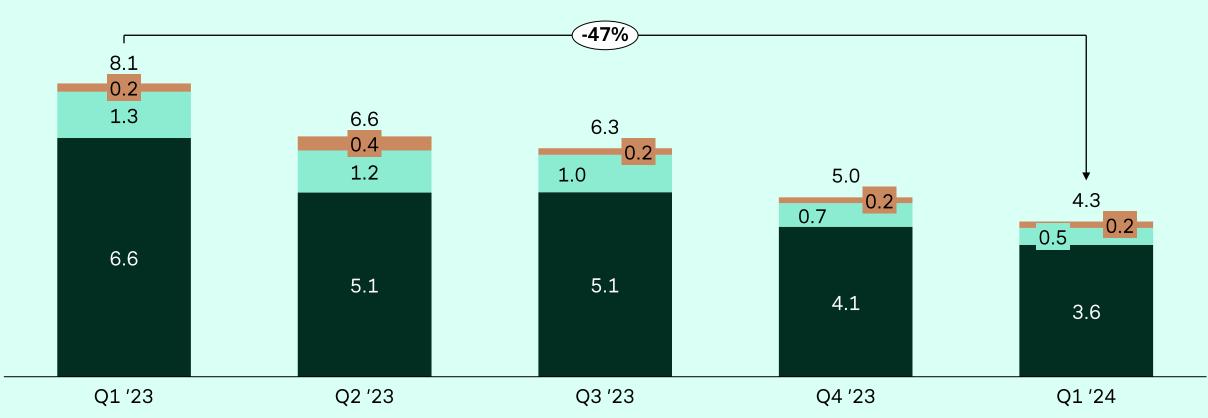

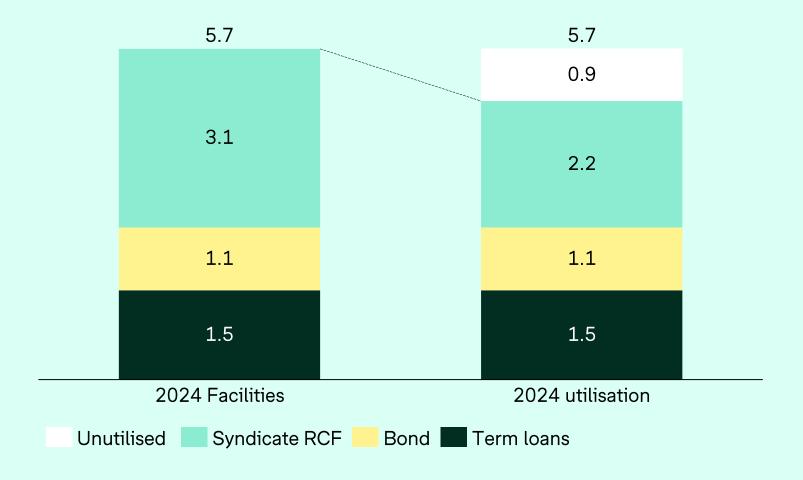
Net debt (SEK Bn)

- Leasing



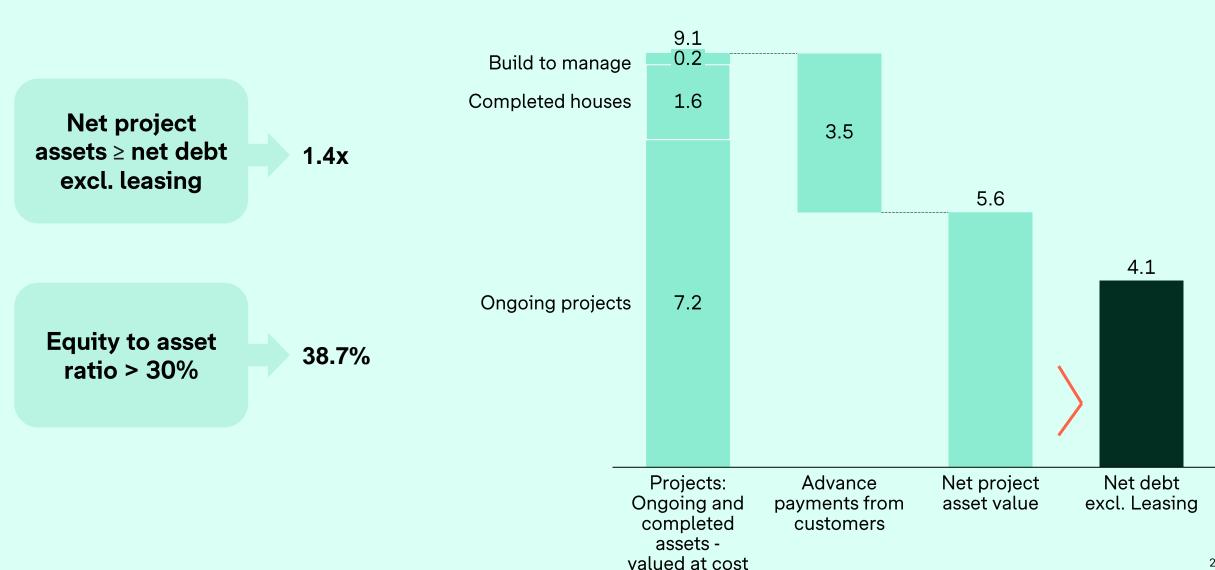
All conditions in financing package fulfilled in March

Well above targets set in new financial framework from 2024



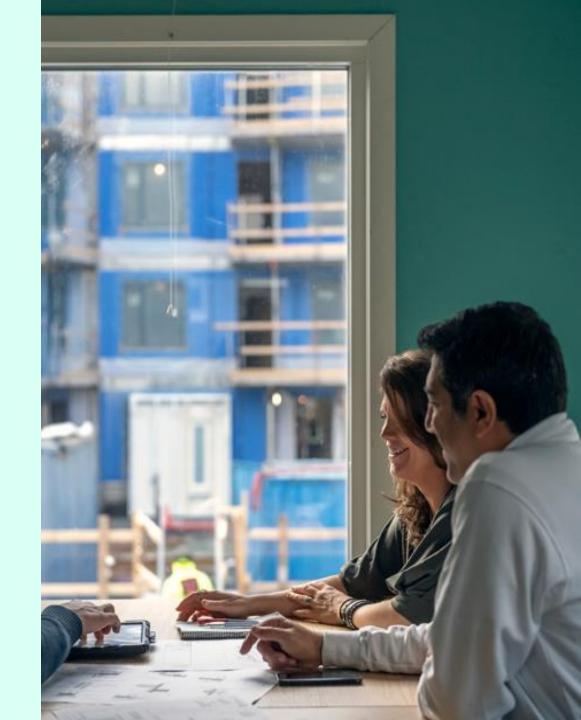
